1. MOTOR
A) Any cubic inch
B) Cast Iron Block
C) No Dry Sump Systems
D) MSD Ignition Allowed (No Magnetos)
E) One two barrel or four barrel carburetor
F) No Turbos/Nitrous
G) No traction control
H) Any battery allowed
I) #1 Spark Plug must be even with the upper ball joint
2. TRANSMISSION
A) Any transmission allowed
B) Must have functional reverse and clutch
3. SUSPENSION
A) Any type rear suspension is allowed
B) 1 shock per corner
C) No Air Shocks
D) No Rack and Pinion Steering
E) Any rearend is permitted
4. CHASSIS
A) 104in Minimum Wheelbase
B) No Full Round Tubed Chassis
C) If you choose to run birdcages you must have a OEM type front stub
5. BODY

- A) Aluminum, Steel, and Composite Bodys are ok.
- B) After market nose pieces are ok. No wedge style late model noses
- C) 8" rear spoiler height max.
- D) Wagon roofs ok. Must have a roof on to race unless told otherwise
- E) Spoiler supports to be no more than 23 1/2 " long
- F) 43" deck height max
- G) 3" rake on roof max on overall length (wagon roofs included)
- H) 78" max width from door to door at the top with 84" across the bottom.
- I) Sail panels are to be no more than 45" in length
- 6. SAFETY
- A) Racing seat required
- B) 5 point nylon quick release harness and safety belt required. Must be in excellent working condition at all times. (Harnesses must be attached to frame)
- C) Approved fire suit mandatory. Fireproof gloves and shoes are mandatory.
- D) Full face helmet is required with lexan shield. (Must be minimum of snell 85 approved.
- E) Neck restraints are highly recommended but not mandatory
- 7. TIRES & WHEELS
- A) Any wheel/tire width allowed
- B) Open tire compound
- C) Grooving and siping is permitted
- D) No chemically altering tires
- 8. WEIGHT
- A) 3,000lbs
